

Honoring Our Local Heroes

Let's take a moment to show our appreciation for some of the heroes in our community!

The firefighters who work at Station #6 on Maple Canyon are some of those heroes. At a recent meeting of the Sharon Woods Civic Association, I asked the firefighters in attendance if anyone in their department had caught COVID-19. They said about half of their station had contracted it, but only one firefighter had to be hospitalized. These firefighters make between 35–40 runs per day, and they are our true community heroes.

Many of us take for granted simple realities that these heroes deal with every day. For example, I recently followed a fire truck on Jewett Drive where traffic calming speed bumps have recently been installed. The bumps are meant to be driven over at 25 MPH, which cars can do easily. However, the fire truck had to slow down to no more than 5 MPH to



cross those bumps safely. I understand that school buses that go over these bumps at 25 MPH give the kids in the very back of the bus a thrill. Our association has not been in favor of speed bumps for the reason that our firefighters need to get to emergencies as fast as possible and don't need anything to slow them down.

Another "thank you" goes out to our many community volunteers. Several people went door-to-door to deliver our summer 2021 issue of *The Gatepost*, ensuring all our Sharon Woods neighbors received a copy. Many others worked to remove weeds from the islands at 161 and Sharon Woods Boulevard. Others put in effort to maintain our sign at Schrock Road and Sharon Woods Boulevard. Corbin Robinson, Mike Shannon, Dave Kilboy, and Pete Frisch helped by trimming the trees at Schrock Road and Sharon Woods Boulevard and by mowing the grass and edging around the sidewalk there. Our volunteers are few in number but do a great job serving our community!

Finally, I want to let you know that several members of our association attend Northland Community Council (NCC) meetings and NCC's community development meetings. NCC is made up of 24 civic, condo, and homeowner associations that meet monthly to discuss issues which relate to the Northland area as well as whether builders meet the Northland Plan when they are planning new development in our area. Being a member of NCC provides our association with access to city officers and an audience to voice our opinion

about what most benefits those in our community. A big "thanks" goes to those who represent us in those important meetings!



Real Estate Trends in Our Community

Anyone who has looked into buying or selling a home recently knows Columbus has a strong seller's market.

In Franklin County and surrounding areas there are only 2,500 active listings, and most sell within a few days of being listed. Limited inventory and historically low interest rates continue to push property prices up. The average price of a home sold in June in Franklin County was \$316,207, an increase of 15.8% from a year ago. The median sale price was \$275,000, an increase of 14.1% over June 2020.

According to the MLS (multiple listing service), a total of 69 properties have sold in the Sharon Woods community since the beginning of the year. The median price during that period was \$252,250 and the highest price was \$310,000. With such a high demand for houses in this fast-moving market, sellers should be ready to move when listing their home! Here are a few tips to help potential sellers prepare for success:








With the changing seasons and cooler weather comes favorite holiday traditions.

Whether it's a family recipe passed down for generations, a favorite movie watched with loved ones, or delivering sweet treats to neighbors, we all have special things that mark the season. For the past 50 years, we have held onto a cherished tradition called "Luminaria," which is the lighting of candles on our property fronts on Christmas Eve.

The Sharon Woods Civic Association invites all residents to participate in this unique experience by placing candles (usually 6–9) in paper bags or plastic milk jugs, weighed down with sand or kitty litter, and placing them along the front of their property on Christmas Eve.
